



**ZEROING ADJUSTMENTS for SCOPE**

Determine distance of 3-shot group (shot from bench rest at 100 yards) from center + (point of aim). On scopes set at 1/4 MOA per click (which is 1/4-inch at 100 yards), make number of click adjustments as needed to bring the point of impact to center + . At 100 yards, click 4 times for each inch of adjustment needed.

If unable put a bullet on paper (grid) at 100 yards, move target in to 25 yards and fire again to determine point of impact. Make click-adjustments as needed, (remembering that at 25 yards, you must multiply the number of clicks by 4 to get an inch of adjustment). After firing another group to determine proper adjustment, move target back to 100 yards to fine tune the zero.
